Sixth Form Dress Code Consultation

In September 2019 we are proposing to simplify our Sixth Form Dress Code in order to ensure that our pupils are appropriately dressed for the school environment as is required for pupils in the lower school.

Our intention is to ensure that sixth form pupils wear clothing that is smart, but comfortable to ensure that they look neat and tidy at all times. We are proposing that all sixth form pupils will adhere to the following dress code:

Boys

- Plain collared shirt
- Tie
- Plain trousers (no Jeans)
- Dark shoes (no trainers)
- Sixth form ID badge must be worn at all times
- Blazer (optional)

Girls

- Plain collared shirt or blouse
- Plain trousers (no Jeans) (or dark coloured skirt - no shorter than 10cm above the knee)
- Dark shoes (no trainers)
- Sixth form ID badge must be worn at all times
- Blazer (optional).
