Uniform Update

Thank you to all of you who have sent me your comments on the proposals for the changes to the sixth form uniform. We will be looking at how we move forward in the coming weeks and will write to you again as soon as possible.

Regarding the lower school uniform for Years 7 to 11, we have made the following changes from September 2019 to ensure consistency:

- We will be introducing a new school skirt with two school logos emblazoned onto it. This style of skirt will be compulsory and other skirts will not be permitted. We are happy for children to continue wearing trousers, all year round, and, in the summer term, smart, knee-length shorts. Other schools in the area have successfully introduced this style of skirt and I feel this will be a positive step for Champion too. The new school skirt will be available from local suppliers, Stitchtech and Chez Rama
- Also, from September 2019, all pupils will be required to wear plain black socks and not bright white socks, which are currently the uniform
- From September 2019, any pupil wearing a turban or hijab will need to ensure that it is black and not any other colour
- Finally, pupils are expected to have a full PE uniform. This is to ensure that they are appropriately dressed for outdoor PE lessons all year round. Rugby is now played as part of the curriculum and, therefore, the PE uniform for boys includes a Rugby top
All pupils are required to wear the Champion School PE fleece - hoodies are not allowed.

The vast majority of our pupils wear their school uniform with pride and I have had many positive comments on their appearance from visitors to the school. These small changes will help the school to ensure consistency as we grow in size.
