

CONSENT FORM FOR PHOTOGRAPHY AND IMAGES OF CHILDREN

Dear Parent or Carer

The school takes official photographs, as part of its public duty, to be able to identify pupils. These are taken in Years 7, 9, 11 and 13 to keep our records up to date, and to comply with legal requirements. These are only used for official purposes.

During the course of the school year, we may, sometimes, wish to take photographs or video recordings of children within school or on school trips, either for our own records, for use as part of our learning curriculum or for inclusion in our publications and promotional material such as the school prospectus, promotional banners, displays and our website. The school may invite the media into school to take photographs of pupils engaged in school activities or events for publication.

Embarrassing or distressing images will not be used, neither will images associated with distressing or sensitive issues. The school will regularly review and delete unnecessary images.

To comply with the General Data Protection Regulations, we need to ask for your consent before the school records any images of your child. In view of this, please read the statements in the online admissions form and confirm your acceptance to them.

This table sets out the various reasons for taking, and making use of, images of your child and we should be grateful if you would indicate whether or not you give consent for use in these circumstances. By indicating 'YES', you are confirming that you consent to your child's personal data being shared for these purposes and/or with the named third parties:

Wherever possible, we avoid naming our pupils, but if it is necessary to attach your child's name to any images accessible externally to the school (for example social media, other websites or the print media) we will use their first names only. Please indicate whether you consent to this
